

The Ordinance of Baptism

What is Baptism?

Baptism is a symbol of what Christ has done in our lives.

Why should I be baptized?

To follow the example set by Jesus. To demonstrate belief and faith to others.

What is the meaning of baptism?

It illustrates Christ's burial and resurrection. It illustrates new life as a Christian.

Why be baptized by immersion?

Because Jesus was baptized that way. Every baptism in the Bible was by immersion. The word 'baptize' means to saturate with water or immerse. The Greek word 'baptizo' means to immerse or completely saturate. It best symbolizes a burial and resurrection.

Who should be baptized?

Every person who has believed in Christ! With regard to our children at Crosspointe Christian Church, we handle their baptism very cautiously to make sure they totally understand what it means to give your heart to Jesus Christ and what the symbolism of baptism truly is. We make sure their parent(s) feel they are prepared for baptism.
