**2 Samuel 11**  
**September 19, 2021**

I. Scene #1 – David Sees, Seeks and Takes (2 Samuel 11.1-5)

*Rather than resist temptation, David succumbs.*

II. Scene #2 – David Plans a Cover Up (2 Samuel 11.6-25)

*Rather than come clean, David descends further into sin.*

III. Scene #3 – David Solves His Problem? (2 Samuel 11.26-27)

*Rather than being covered up, David's sin is still there.*

## **How are you confronting the sin in your life?**

### On Your Own or with Your Family

Reread 1 Samuel 11.1-27. List the many opportunities that David had to turn away from his sin.

The Bible has a lot to say about temptation and how we can deal with it. Consider these passages: 1 Corinthians 10.13; James 1.13-14; James 4.7; Psalm 119.11. Read them and journal or talk about what each of them teaches in regard to temptation.

Think about areas where you are tempted to sin. How can you work to build off-ramps in your life so that you can move away from those sins? Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to help you as you confront those sins in your life this week.

Who have you hurt because of the sin in your life? Is there anything you can do to begin the healing process? Start with prayer. Then share the situation with a friend who you trust and who follows Jesus as well. Talk about what your next steps might be.
