Can you think of a recent instance where you provoked your child or someone else? Work out a time to sit down with that person and explain your failure and ask for their forgiveness.

While Jesus was not a father, the way that he treated people around him gives us a good example of what it means to nourish someone else in a relationship. Read John 3-6 and identify ways that Jesus’s behavior and words nourished those around him. How can this translate to your life?

When do you find yourself more apt to dragging someone down rather than bringing someone up? Why do you think that is?

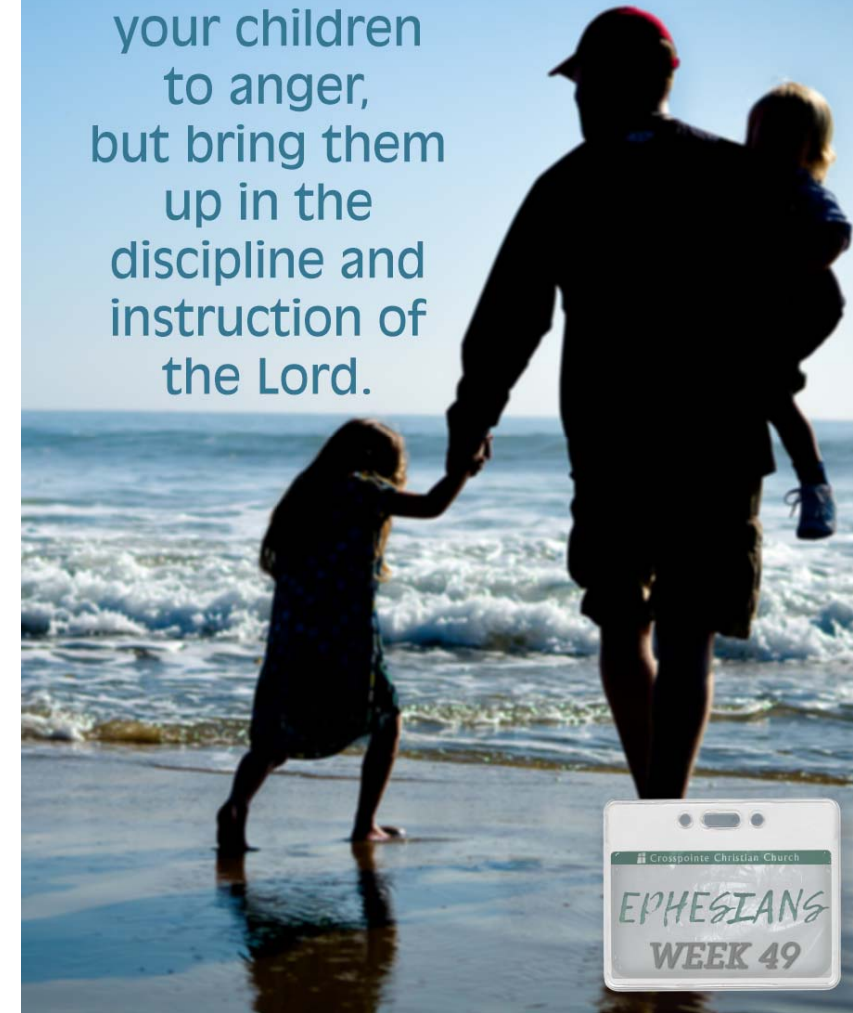
