Who was Barnabas?

4 Snapshots of Encouragement

Snapshot #1 – Encouragement Through Personal Sacrifice

1. Barnabas was willing to personally sacrifice for the sake of the Gospel. (Acts 4.34-37)
2. What am I willing to sacrifice for others?

Snapshot #2 – Encouragement Through Faith

1. Barnabas had faith in the power of the Gospel. (Acts 9.26-32)
2. Is my faith strong like that of Barnabas?

Snapshot #3 – Encouragement Through Embrace

1. Barnabas embraced others because of their faith in Christ, regardless of their background. (Acts 11)

2. Who should I embrace?

Snapshot #4 – Encouragement Through Willingness to Serve

1. Barnabas was willing to be sent out by the church to bring the message of Jesus to others. (Acts 13-15)

2. Am I willing to be used?

Are you living a life like Barnabas?

On Your Own or with Your Family

Take some time to read through the following passages: Ephesians 4.29; Hebrews 10.25; 1 Thessalonians 5.11; Galatians 6.2; 1 Corinthians 14.31; What do they say about encouragement?

In what ways has the sacrifice of others encouraged you? Can you identify specific ways that you could sacrifice in order to encourage other people as well? Use the encouragement card as a start!

Barnabas is one example of someone in Scripture who was an encourager. Can you think of other examples from the Bible?

Reread the passages listed in the sermon notes and see if you notice anything else about Barnabas and his life of encouragement. How can you practice similar actions in your own life?
