ROAR! VBS is coming to C3 June 17-21

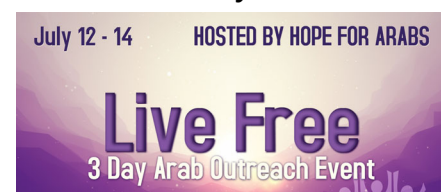

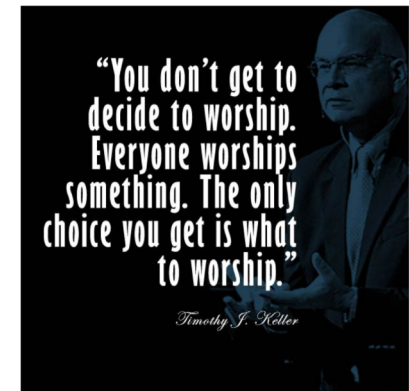
