We have three choices when running the marathon of faith:

CHOICE #1 - We can

Key phrase: "went out from us."

- a. Some leave for other teaching
- b. Some leave to avoid religion

CHOICE #2 – We can try to

Key word: "denies"

- a. They deny that Jesus is the Messiah.
- b. They deny that Jesus is God.

How to persevere - Cling to the truth

CHOICE #3 - We can \_\_\_\_\_

Key word: "abide"

- a. To abide is to accept the truth.
- b. To abide is to interact with the truth.

How to persevere - Interact with the truth

## On Your Own or with Your Family

The metaphor of faith and a race is one that is used several times in Scripture. Take some time to look through the following passages and journal your thoughts on each passage: Philippians 3.13-14; 1 Corinthians 9.24-27; Hebrews 12.1; Isaiah 40.31.

Perseverance in faith is a common theme throughout the Bible. Take some time to look at the life of Joseph in Genesis 37-50. How did Joseph persevere? How might this apply to your life?

Spend time in prayer this week thinking specifically of other people that you can pray for as they run the race set before them. Consider people who have seemingly quit the race. Think about people who have embraced a lie. And then think of those who are running well and pray for their continued faithfulness. Ask God to be with you as you try to run well the race set before you.


