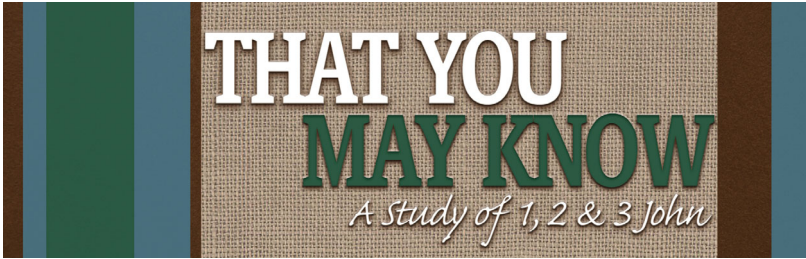
MOPS at Crosspointe

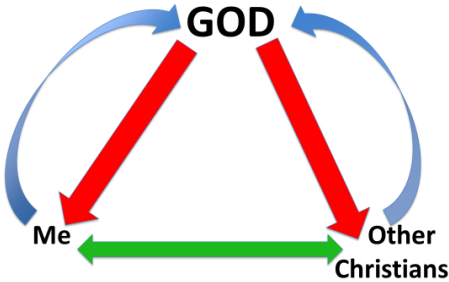

On Your Own or with Your Family

We have talked about tests like behavior, belief and love. Now John introduces another one, the presence of the Holy Spirit. What are some of the evidences that the Spirit is present in your life? Consider these passages and what they have to say about the Spirit’s presence in your life: **Ezekiel 36.27; Galatians 5.21-24; John 14.26; Romans 8.26; Luke 11.13.**

What are you afraid of? Share with your family or with a friend what scares you. When John says that perfect love casts out fear, he is speaking specifically about the fear of the future. Do you think perfect love can also cast out whatever you are afraid of? Why or why not?

One of the main themes of 1 John is that believers should be loving one another. Why is this so difficult at times? One way to start loving people that you find difficult to love is to pray for them. For the next seven days, each day pray for another Christian that you have a hard time loving. Don’t pray that they will change. Pray that God will bless them, that their day will go well, that they will find happiness etc.
