Faith Under Construction

Forgiveness

Ephesians 4:25-32

What is forgiveness? Ken Sande says that forgiveness may be described as a decision to make four promises:

- 1) I will not dwell on this incident.
- 2) I will not bring up this incident again and use it against you.
- 3) I will not talk to others about this incident.
- 4) I will not let this incident stand between us or hinder our personal relationship.

How can we cultivate a community of forgiveness?

- I. Remember God's Forgiveness (Psalm 103.10-14; 1 John 1.9)
 - A. Our sins have been removed in Christ.
 - B. Our forgiveness depends on God's faithfulness, not our failures.
- II. Realize Our Duty to Forgive (Colossians 3.13; Ephesians 4.32)

A. Forgiven people forgive people.

B. Forgiveness isn't optional.

III. Rejoice in the Beauty of Forgiveness (Matthew 18.21-22; Acts 2.38)

A. Forgiveness should be given joyfully.

B. Forgiveness allows our "light" to shine.

Who do you need to forgive?

"Who do you need to ask for forgiveness?"

On Your Own or With Your Family

Read through the various passages mentioned above. What did you learn about forgiveness? What should you do with what you learned?

When is the last time that you asked someone for forgiveness? Did you handle that situation appropriately? In light of what we have talked about today would you have done anything differently?

Are you withholding forgiveness from someone? Ask the Holy Spirit to make it evident in your heart if you should have forgiven someone but have not. Then plan to make amends for that situation, if appropriate, and seek forgiveness.
