## Baby and Child Dedication

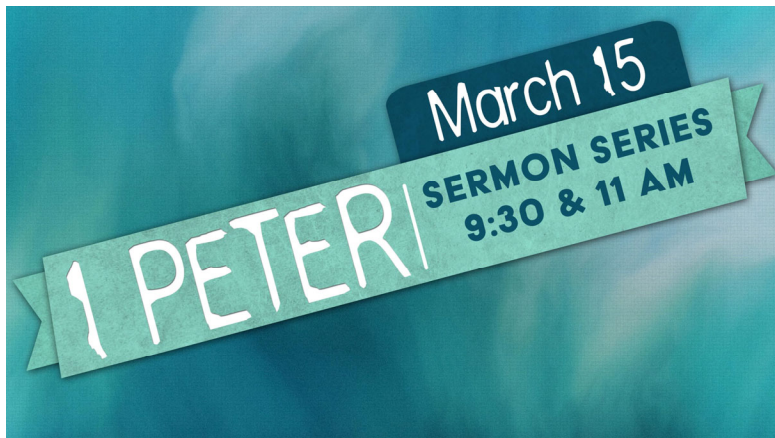
