Ron Seck Sermon Notes Moving Mountains Matthew 17:14-20; Mark 9:14-19; Luke 9:37-43 March 1, 2020

"Because you have so little faith. Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you." Matthew 17:20

- I. The Faith of the Religious Leaders could not move any mountains because it was not focused on the right object.
- II. The faith of the crowd could not move any mountains because it was only "spectator" faith.
- III. The faith of the father could not move this mountain because it was double focused.
- IV. The faith of the disciples could not move this mountain because it lacked prayer and persistence.
 - A. To Move Mountains, we must pray in faith with persistence.
 - 1. Matthew 9:29
 - 2. John 15:5,7

- B. To Move Mountains, we must believe with persistence.
 - 1. The "Great Faith" of the Canaanite Woman persisted. Matthew 15:22-28
 - 2. The "little faith' of the disciples often did not persist.
 - a) In the storm—Matthew 8:26
 - b) Walking on the water—Matthew 14:31
 - c) Casting out powerful, resistant unclean spirit.
 - 3. Matthew 17:20 The mustard seed though it is small gives off a strong, persistent, active odor and taste.

V. The Faith Jesus demonstrated moved mountains.

The Big Idea: When Jesus calls you to do something that requires moving a mountain, believe He will do it, pray that He will do it, work with Him to do it, and don't stop until He moves it.
