Business Meeting Today
Crosspointe will hold a special business meeting today after the 11 a.m. service, to vote on the following items:

- recommendation from the Leadership Board to approve the expenditure of GPNS funds for the installation of a privacy fence along the south side of the GPNS playground and around the play area north of the garage in an amount not to exceed \$35,000.
- recommendation from the Leadership Board to approve the use of a previously approved Parsonage Fund Reserve. The amount would be a loan of \$15,000 for help with the down payment and improvement for the Parsonage for Pastor Jason and Becky Coplen.
- recommendation from the Leadership Board to approve the expenditure of Crosspointe Church funds for waterproofing the entire south wall of the basement, that is adjacent to the Nursery School playground. The amount would not exceed \$60,000.

Ephesians 6.12-15

¹² For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.
¹³ Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm. ¹⁴ Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness ¹⁵ and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace.
