As we partake of communion today, please note that gluten free wafers are available in individual cups on each communion tray.

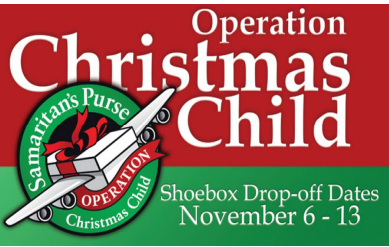
Members—Special Business Meeting November 20
