On Your Own or with Your Family

Daniel went decades between interpreting Nebuchadnezzar's vision in chapter 2 and experiencing this vision in chapter 7. He didn't have the entire picture the entire time. Can you identify a time in your life when you did not have the entire picture but God was at work?

There are a lot of similarities between the account of Daniel and the account of Joseph. Read Genesis 37-50 and identify similarities in their lives. What does this tell us about God?

Daniel's vision, while terrifying, looked to the future with the understanding that God is in control. Consider these passages about God and the future: John 16.33; Revelation 21.4; Proverbs 16.9; Isaiah 43.2. What do these passages tell us?
