**November 17, 2019**  
**Daniel 10:1-21**

Daniel Timeline to this point -

605 BC - Nebuchadnezzar attacks Jerusalem and Daniel and his friends are exiled to \_\_\_\_\_.

597 BC - Nebuchadnezzar attacks Jerusalem and takes 10,000 captive including Ezekiel the prophet

587 BC - Nebuchadnezzar builds the large statue that the 3 Hebrew boys refuse to worship

586 BC - Jerusalem is \_\_\_\_\_.

554 BC - Belshazzar becomes King

539 BC - Belshazzar brings Daniel in to read the writing on the wall,

- Belshazzar is killed that night

- Cyrus becomes King

- Daniel is thrown to the \_\_\_\_\_

538 BC - Cyrus permits 50,000 Jews to return to Jerusalem and rebuild the Temple (Ezra 2)

536 BC - Daniel has his apocalyptic visions of Chapters 10-12. Temple building has stalled due to opposition those inhabiting the land (Ezra 4). Daniel is around \_\_\_\_\_ years old.
