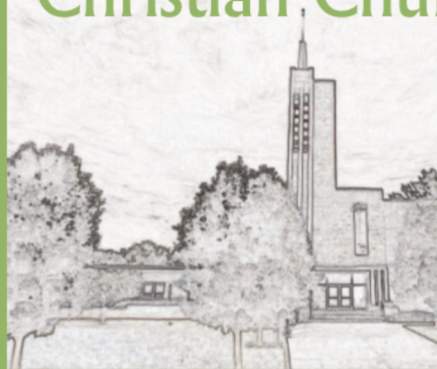

unsearchable riches of Christ.” *(1954 Dedication)*



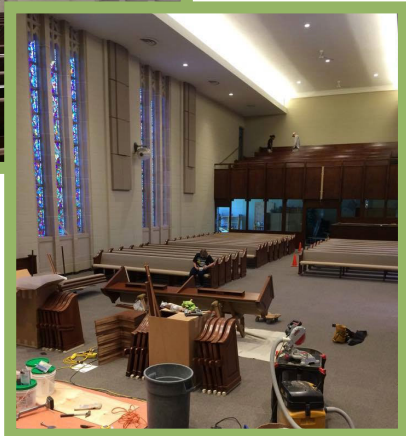
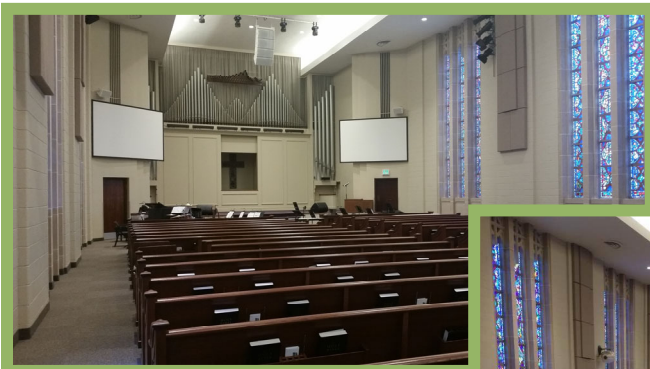
“With fond memories of the past and challenging dreams of the future, the congregation relocated in 1955 to Baseline and Mack,

Serve the Present

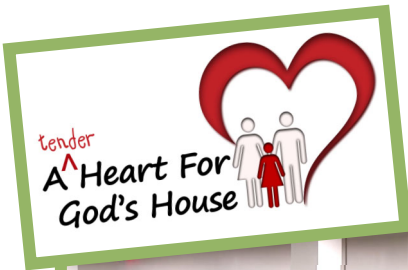
Working in tandem with our mission is our strategic vision: reaching families of the community through effective children and student ministries.

With the strategic vision in mind, our Crosspointe family enthusiastically embraced **A Tender Heart for God's House**. This provided the opportunity to create a fully refreshed and invigorated, dedicated Children and Student Ministry space on the lower level. Tender

Heart projects finished in 2017 and the lower level has been bustling with ministry activities every since.



Completion of A Heart for God's House and A Tender Heart for God's House projects impacted far more than the physical building.

Stewards make decisions to benefit the Master, not the steward. As His stewards, we are given the privilege to decide how much of His money we invest in the ministry and how much we spend on ourselves.

Provide for the Future



Currently, it is impossible for children and students with special needs that require a wheelchair to participate in activities on the lower level.

Adults who require assistance on the stairs or are in a wheelchair cannot drop off their own child to class, volunteer in children or student ministry classes that meet on the lower level, or participate in meals or special events hosted in the fellowship hall.

There is no access to these dedicated ministry spaces unless you are able to navigate at least one flight of stairs.

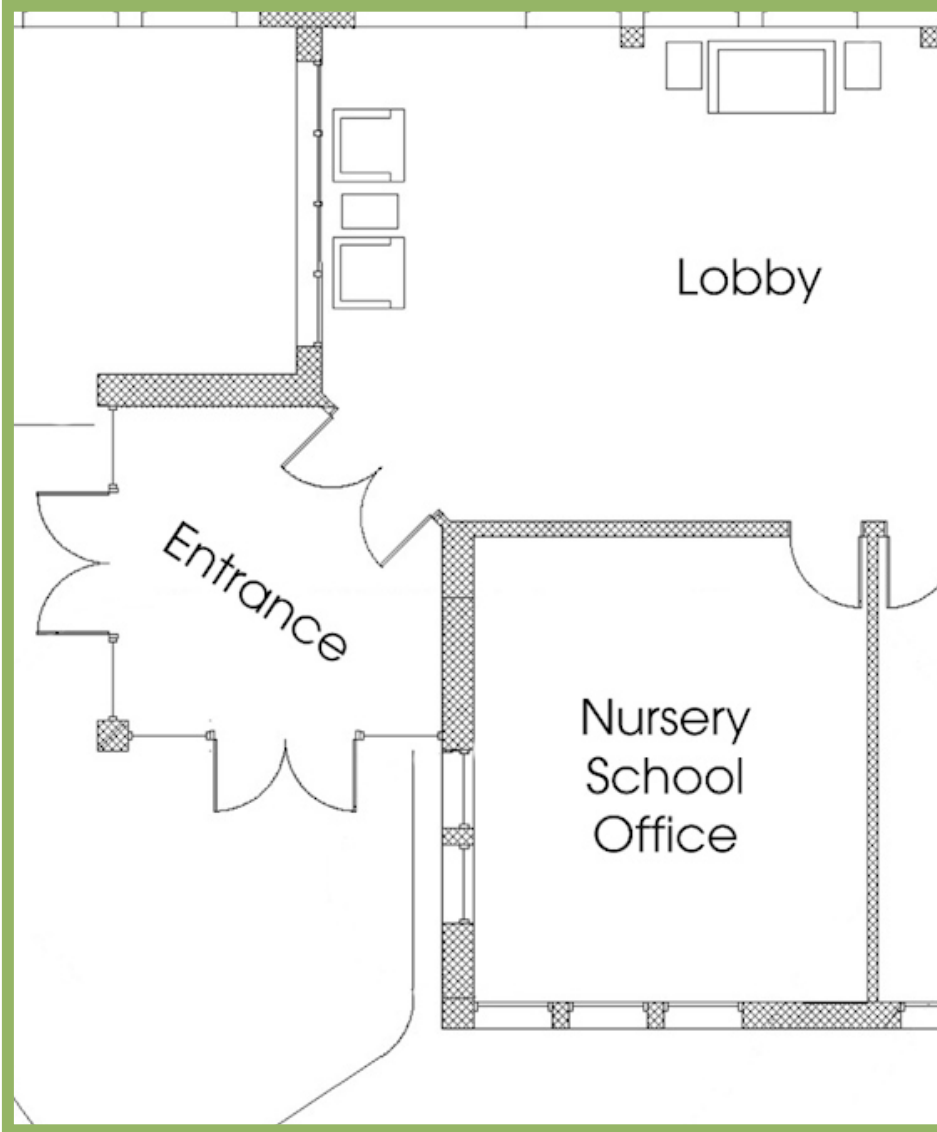

The Lord has entrusted us with His wealth to do good on earth. Imagine how you, through Building on the Vision, can impact people for Christ.

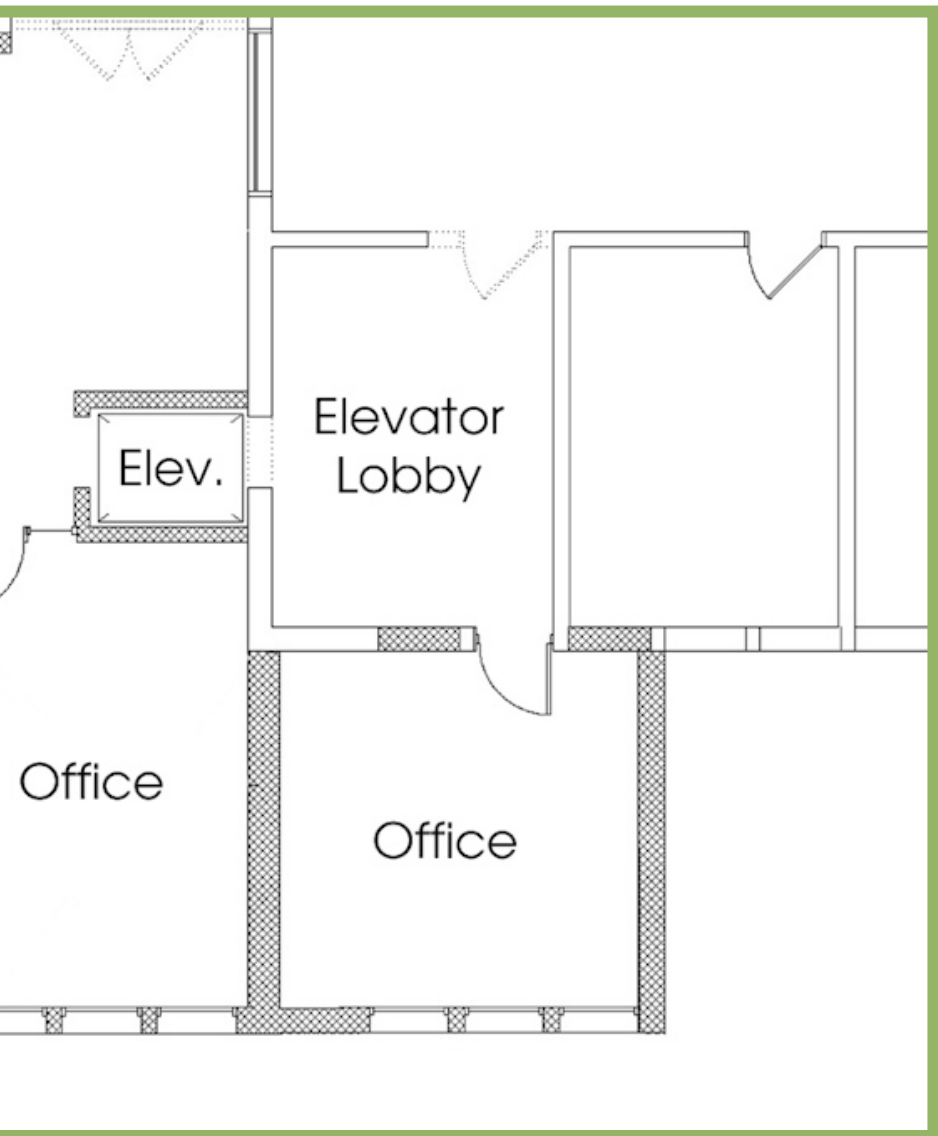

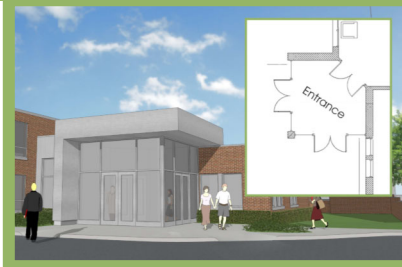

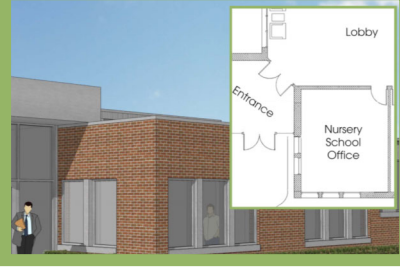

Nursery School Office



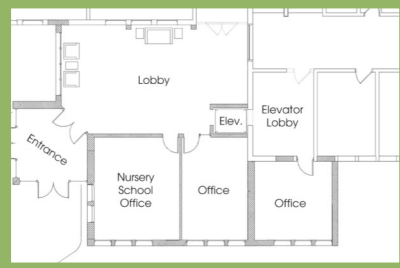
- Closer to Vestibule for Improved Security
