CROSSPOINTE CHRISTIAN CHURCH Commitment Card Information

First, thank you in advance for making a commitment to the campaign. Your commitment is confidential and will be seen only by those responsible for record keeping for all giving to Crosspointe Christian Church.

Step One: If you have not already done so, please seek, through prayer, God's leading about your commitment. He will not lead you to a figure and then not provide a way for its fulfillment. Remember, this is a commitment to be fulfilled over three years so you are encouraged to review the chart (on reverse) showing how gifts "grow" over time.

To reach our financial goal will require our congregation to engage in sacrificial giving over and above current giving. It may require "giving up" something that you might otherwise have purchased or postponing a vacation. You may decide to provide a gift of stock or personal property or real estate in addition to cash gifts.

Step Two: Once you have come to a prayerful decision concerning your commitment, consider how the total amount will be provided over the three-year period. Please understand that the same amounts do not have to be given each year. For example, you may have a circumstance that will cause you to give less the first year and give more the last two years. Or, you may wish to give a stock gift and fulfill your commitment entirely in the first week of the fulfillment period.

After the determination as to how the commitment will be fulfilled, please put a financial amount and the method of fulfillment, i.e. monthly, quarterly, etc. in the spaces provided. If none of the options provided fit your situation, please write your intention on the card. Use the back of the card if needed. This information will assist the church in understanding the "cash flow" of the campaign.

Step Three: Please print your name(s) and sign your name(s) on the card. This is so the commitment can be assigned to the correct person/family. Record keepers will then be able to respond if you have a question concerning your commitment. This is not a legally binding document.

Step Four: The church has available a checking withdrawal program whereby you can agree to have regular gifts to the campaign automatically withdrawn from your checking account. If you are interested in more information about this, please check the box provided on the commitment

card and you will be contacted concerning this potential program. Also, you can go to our website and send your campaign gifts.

Step Five: If you are considering a stock gift or gift of another type of appreciated property, be sure to check the box on the commitment card and you will be contacted by Jim Johnson to discuss this option in detail. It is OK to put the estimated value of such a gift on your commitment card, but please make sure you meet with Jim prior to actually making the gift in order to make sure it is done in a way that provides you the most in terms of a tax deduction.

Step Six: Place the commitment card in the envelope provided and bring it to church on Commitment Sunday – June 2. Commitments will be turned in both services via special collection. No one will be asked to come forward to make a commitment.

Step Seven: First Fruits Sunday is June 9. All who make commitments are encouraged to bring a campaign gift to church to begin the fulfillment period of the campaign. All checks need to be made payable to Crosspointe Christian Church with the word CAMPAIGN in the memo section of the check.
