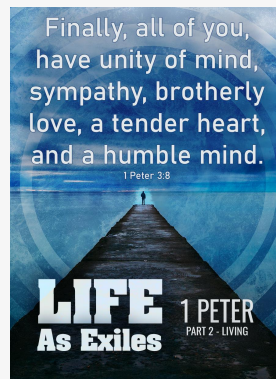

1 Peter 3:8-12

A. The importance of a Godly attitude.

1. Have unity of mind.

John 17:21 That they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me.

2. Have sympathy.

Romans 12:15 Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep

from evil and his lips from speaking deceit; let him turn away from evil and do good; let him seek peace and pursue it. For the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, and his ears are open to their prayer. But the face of the Lord is against those who do evil.”

1 Thessalonians 4:9 Now concerning brotherly love you have no need for anyone to write to you, for you yourselves have been taught by God to love one another,

4. Have a tender heart.

5. Have a humble mind.

1 Peter 5:5... Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for “God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.”

B. The importance of a Godly response.

Leviticus 19:18 You shall not take vengeance or bear a grudge against the sons of your own people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself: I am the Lord.

Proverbs 20:22 Do not say, “I will repay evil”; wait for the Lord, and he will deliver you.

Luke 6:27 “But I say to you who hear, Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, ²⁸ bless those who curse you, pray for those who abuse you.

Romans 12:14 Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse them.

1 Thessalonians 5:15 See that no one repays anyone evil for evil, but always seek to do good to one another and to everyone.

“Blessing my enemy is treating others like God is treating me.”

C. The importance of motivation and warning.

1. The motivation explained.

Psalms 19:14 Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in your sight,

O Lord, my rock and my redeemer.

Hebrews 13:5 Keep your life free from love of money, and be content with what you have, for he has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." So we can confidently say, "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear; what can man do to me?"

Psalms 34:4 I sought the Lord, and he answered me and delivered me from all my fears.

⁵ Those who look to him are radiant, and their faces shall never be ashamed.

⁶ This poor man cried, and the Lord heard him and saved him out of all his troubles.

⁷ The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear him, and delivers them.

2. The warning explained.

1 Peter 4:12 ... But the face of the Lord is against those who do evil."

John 12:48 The one who rejects me and does not receive my words has a judge; the word that I have spoken will judge him on the last day.

2 Thessalonians 1:7... when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with his mighty angels ⁸ in flaming fire, inflicting vengeance on those who do not know God and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus.

Romans 2:4 Or do you presume on the riches of his kindness and forbearance and patience, not knowing that God's kindness is meant to lead you to repentance?
