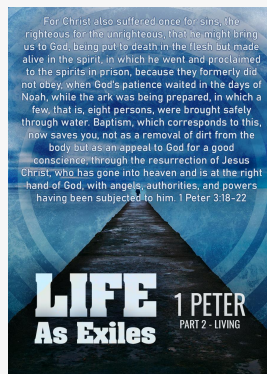

For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit, in which he went and proclaimed to the spirits in prison, because they formerly did not obey, when God's patience waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were brought safely through water. Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, with angels, authorities, and powers having been subjected to him. 1 Peter 3:18-22

**Jesus Is King
1 Peter 3:18-22**

1. We have hope in suffering because of the work of Christ on the Cross vs 18

- A. We have hope because Christ also suffered
- B. We have hope because one of the purposes of Jesus' death on the cross was to be the justification for our sins (righteous for the unrighteous)
- C. In Jesus' death and resurrection, we are made alive.

2. We have hope in suffering because Jesus declared himself victorious vs 19-20

A. What did Jesus do during the 3 days that his body was buried in the tomb? -Jesus declared himself victorious to the angels that sinned before the days of Noah

B. Who were these angels?

- Genesis 6:1-8
- Jude 6-7
- 2 Peter 2:4-6

- Spirits were incorporeal
- Spirits were imprisoned
- Their sin was before the flood

Jesus went to their place of imprisonment and declared himself victorious over sin and death. The very thing those angels chose to rebelliously participate in.

3. We have hope in suffering because we are baptized by the Holy Spirit vs 21

A. Just as Noah was removed or set apart from the rest of the sin stained world, so are believers set apart by the Holy Spirit in what we call Spirit Baptism.

- Spirit Baptism is a work of God by which the Holy Spirit places the new believer into the family of God - 1 Corinthians 12:13
- This is another reminder that our citizenship is not here but rather in heaven.

4. We have hope in suffering because Jesus reigns as King over all vs 22

A. Jesus resides and reigns in heaven

B. All things are under his rule and reign

- Jesus reigns over the angels
- Jesus reigns over Authorities
- Jesus reigns over Powers
