Ephesians 4:22 to put off your old self, which belongs to your former manner of life and is corrupt through deceitful desires, ²³ and to be renewed in the spirit of your minds, ²⁴ and to put on the new self, created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness.

1 John 3:2 Beloved, we are God's children now, and what we will be has not yet appeared; but we know that when he appears we shall be like him, because we shall see him as he is. ³ And everyone who thus hopes in him purifies himself as he is pure.

Titus 2:11 For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, ¹² training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age,

Hebrews 12:14 Strive for peace with everyone, and for the holiness without which no one will see the Lord.

- 2 Timothy 2:21 Therefore, if anyone cleanses himself from what is dishonorable, he will be a vessel for honorable use, set apart as holy, useful to the master of the house, ready for every good work.

- 3. How do we pursue holiness?

Romans 7:19 For I do not do the good I want, but the evil I do not want is what I keep on doing...21 So I find it to be a law that when I want to do right, evil lies close at hand.

- 1 Peter 1:13 Therefore, preparing your minds for action, and being sober-minded, set your hope fully on the grace that will be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ.
- 1 Peter 1:14 As obedient children, do not be

conformed to the passions of your former ignorance,

Ephesians 4:22 to put off your old self, which belongs to your former manner of life and is corrupt through deceitful desires, ²³ and to be renewed in the spirit of your minds, ²⁴ and to put on the new self, created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness.

Colossians 3:5 Put to death therefore what is earthly in you: sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. ⁶ On account of these the wrath of God is coming. ⁷ In these you too once walked, when you were living in them. ⁸ But now you must put them all away:

Question 1: Is it helpful—physically, spiritually, and mentally?

"Everything is permissible for me'—but not everything is beneficial" 1 Corinthians 6:12.

Question 2: Does it bring me under its power?

"Everything is permissible for me'—but I will not be mastered by anything" 1 Corinthians 6:12.

Question 3: Does it hurt others?

"Therefore, if what I eat causes my brother to fall into sin, I will never eat meat again, so that I will not cause him to fall" 1 Corinthians 8:13.

Question 4: Does it glorify God?

"So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God"

1 Corinthians 10:31.
